ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ___ 1. Complete and submit CCC Application for Admission at <http://www.carteret.edu/Admission/>
- ___ 2. Must be a citizen of the United States.
- ___ 3. Must be twenty (20) years of age by the first class meeting. *(Cadet may be nineteen (19) years of age in some cases, but must be twenty years of age (20) by the date of the state exam and must have an approved waiver from the NC Criminal Justice Training and Standards Commission. See the BLET Coordinator for more information.)*
- ___ 4. Must have graduated from high school, GED, or adult high school.
- ___ 5. Must submit official transcript from high school attended or official GED/AHS scores.
Photocopies of diploma or faxed transcripts are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- ___ 6. Complete the placement test, with a COMPASS reading scale score of 78 or better or an ASSET reading scale score of 41. ***Prior college credit cannot be used to waive reading testing.***
- ___ 7. Schedule an information session with the BLET Coordinator at (252) 222-6228 or at jer@carteret.edu. **
- ___ 8. Must have complete, certified background check done prior to first class meeting, from all locations you have lived since the age of 16. *(See the BLET Coordinator for instructions).*
- ___ 10. Possess a valid driver's license.
- ___ 11. Must be eligible under NC Administrative Code: T12:09B.0100 for criminal justice employment.
- ___ 12. Obtain sponsorship letter from the BLET Coordinator.
- ___ 13. Registration *(Cannot register without completed Sponsorship Letter).*
- ___ 14. Payment of fees and submit a copy of the Sponsorship Letter to the Cashier's Office.
- ___ 15. Completed physical examination and medical history forms by the first class meeting.

**The interview will serve to acquaint applicants with the expectations and demands of the program, as well as initiate the final steps of the process such as obtaining background check and sponsorship information.

NOTE: BLET does transfer 10 credit hours into the Associate in Applied Science - Criminal Justice Technology program. The following courses transfer into this program from the BLET program: CJC 121 – 3 hours, CJC 131 – 3 hours, and CJC 221 – 4 hours.

BLET students, who are contemplating getting a 2 yr AA degree and afterward decide to transfer to a 4-year institution, may NOT receive credit from the 4-year institution for those courses because of the transfer credits.
