ONLINE ENCYCLOPEDIAS

Magill's Medical Guide Online (Available on CCC Campus only)

Print copy is in the Health & Fitness Collection, (REF RC41 .M34 2008) 5 volumes.

This medical encyclopedia is an up-to-date and easy-to-use compendium of medical information suitable for student research as well as use by general readers, including patients and caregivers. The *Guide* covers diseases, disorders, treatments, procedures, specialties, anatomy, biology, and issues in an A-Z format, with sidebars addressing recent developments in medicine and concise information boxes for all diseases and disorders.

MEDLINE plus via the National Library of Medicine & NC LIVE

Developed by the National Library of Medicine at the National Institutes of Health, the site contains extensive, high quality information on common diseases and conditions, health promotion and wellness, prescription and non-prescription drugs, medical dictionaries and more. Common diseases and conditions are arranged under "Health Topics". There are also interactive health tutorials and information on clinical trials.

NC LIVE DATABASES

CINAHL with Full Text (Nursing) via EBSCOhost

This database contains full text articles from over 550 nursing and allied health journals. Of those, nearly 400 have cover-to-cover indexing in *CINAHL*. With more than 600,000 full-text articles dating back to 1982, *CINAHL with Full Text* is the definitive research tool for all areas of nursing and allied health literature.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition via EBSCOhost

This database provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. *Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition* also features abstracts and indexing for nearly 850 journals. This database is updated on a daily basis. It is also available in a Consumer Edition.

PubMed via the National Library of Medicine

A service of the National Library of Medicine, PubMed provides access to over 11 million citations from MEDLINE and additional life science journals. PubMed includes links to many sites providing full text articles and other related resources.

Learning Express Library: Learning Express is a comprehensive, interactive online library of practice tests and tutorials designed to help you succeed in academic or licensing tests.
