## ***The Career Center***

Architectural and mechanical design is complete and bid packages have been released for renovation of the Carteret Community College Career Center. This center will focus on success and career coaching, employer job placement, skill development, and military/veterans assistance in collaboration with NC Commerce and NC Works.

The Career Center is located on Arendell Street adjacent to College property, providing easy access for students and community members, as well as local industry, and small businesses. Construction and renovations starting soon!



## ***Hospitality & Culinary Arts Center***

If you have been by the campus lately, you will see that construction is underway on the new Hospitality & Culinary Arts Center. This state-of-the-art center will provide 16,928 square feet of modern instructional classroom, lab and event space with designated training labs for Culinary Arts, Hospitality Arts, and Baking & Pastry Arts. These educational labs will host commercial-quality equipment for students to have a modern educational experience that will prepare them to enter the workforce. The event space will allow for an intimate gathering of up to 150 people and the outdoor patio will be fully equipped for outdoor occasions. Completion date: July 2020!
